The meeting was called to order by Jeff Campbell at 7:10PM

Approval of May 20, 2010 Minutes – Missy moved to approve the minutes; Cheryl seconded the motion and it passed.

Marci Mondello-King – Marci came to this meeting to clear up a misunderstanding that occurred during the Maple Festival. She apologized for any confusion, and explained that neither she nor her husband meant any ill-will. She presented Jeff with a 25 dollar donation.

Financial Report – Jen reported receiving a check for 52.30 from Thalia for the pizza party, and we know that some money was also allotted to CoCo for pool party items. Thalia reported through Jeff that she had submitted a letter to the IRS to line up our calendar year with the tax year.
